

Re: **Management and Non Union Salary Increase Recommendation**

We have or will be conducting our annual employee reviews for full-time management, non-union, and union employees during the month of May and June. Based on the annual reviews, I am recommending wage adjustments for the following management and non-union (liquor store) employees. **These salary increases will go into effect June 1, 2023.**

The AFSCME collective bargaining agreement (CBA) allows for a 2.75% wage adjustment for their members in 2023-2024, which will also go into effect June 1. In keeping in alignment with AFSCME members, I am recommending a 3.0% wage adjustment for all non-union and management staff for 2023-2024.

I am recommending a 0.25% increase more than the CBA, as I made a mistake last year recommending a 0.25% increase less than the 2.75% adjustment the CBA provided in 2022-2023. I want to even the pay increases.

I am also recommending a salary adjustment for the fire chief, as well. He has shown tremendous leadership and poise keeping our fire department together the past 1 ½ years during a period of turmoil and uncertainty of the department. I believe he is worth far more than this salary, but we need to increase salaries in increments and always be conscientious of our annual budget.

New Juneteenth Holiday Will Be Effective This Year

May 23, 2023

A provision included in the state and local government omnibus bill adjusts the previous effective date to make the holiday required this year.

A bill to establish Juneteenth as a state-recognized holiday, [HF 48](#) (Rep. Ruth Richardson, DFL-Mendota Heights/Sen. Bobby Champion, DFL-Minneapolis), was passed off the Senate floor on Jan. 26 with a vote of 57-8. On Feb. 2, it was passed by the House by a vote of 126-1. The bill was signed into law by Gov. Tim Walz.

The holiday is to recognize the date on which slavery was abolished in the United States. Public business cannot be conducted on June 19 in observance of the holiday.

The new law was set to go into effect on Aug. 1, 2023, however, a provision contained in [HF 1830](#) (Rep. Ginny Klevorn, DFL-Plymouth/Sen. Samakab Hussein, DFL-St. Paul), the state and local government omnibus bill, changes the effective date to make the new holiday effective before June 19 of this year, requiring that the day be observed.

The HF 1830 conference committee report containing the updated effective date was passed by the House and Senate and will now go to Gov. Tim Walz to be signed. Cities will need to update their existing schedules to reflect the June 19 holiday and make any necessary adjustments.

CHAPTER 5--S.F.No. 13

An act relating to state government; recognizing Juneteenth, June 19, as a state holiday; amending Minnesota Statutes 2022, sections 10.55; 645.44, subdivision 5.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 10.55, is amended to read:

10.55 JUNETEENTH.

(a) ~~The third Saturday in June 19 of each year~~ is designated Juneteenth in recognition of the historical pronouncement of the abolition of slavery on June 19, 1865, when the Emancipation Proclamation was said to have been first publicly read in Texas by Union soldiers led by General Granger. The announcement came 2-1/2 years after President Abraham Lincoln's Emancipation Proclamation and two months after General Lee's surrender in April 1865. Juneteenth and emancipation celebrations have been commonplace in Minnesota since 1889 as a result of community-based grassroots efforts.

(b) Each year the governor shall issue a proclamation honoring this observance and recognizing the important contributions African-Americans have made to Minnesota's communities, culture, and economy. The governor may also take any additional action necessary to promote and encourage the observance of Juneteenth and public schools may offer instruction and programs on the occasion.

Sec. 2. Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 645.44, subdivision 5, is amended to read:

Subd. 5. **Holiday.** "Holiday" includes New Year's Day, January 1; Martin Luther King's Birthday, the third Monday in January; Washington's and Lincoln's Birthday, the third Monday in February; Memorial Day, the last Monday in May; ~~Juneteenth, June 19;~~ Independence Day, July 4; Labor Day, the first Monday in September; Christopher Columbus Day, the second Monday in October; Veterans Day, November 11; Thanksgiving Day, the fourth Thursday in November; and Christmas Day, December 25; provided, when New Year's Day, January 1; ~~or Juneteenth, June 19;~~ or Independence Day, July 4; or Veterans Day, November 11; or Christmas Day, December 25; falls on Sunday, the following day shall be a holiday and, provided, when New Year's Day, January 1; ~~or Juneteenth, June 19;~~ or Independence Day, July 4; or Veterans Day, November 11; or Christmas Day, December 25; falls on Saturday, the preceding day shall be a holiday. No public business shall be transacted on any holiday, except in cases of necessity and except in cases of public business transacted by the legislature, nor shall any civil process be served thereon. However, for the executive branch of the state of Minnesota, "holiday" also includes the Friday after Thanksgiving but does not include Christopher Columbus Day. Other branches of state government and political subdivisions shall have the option of determining whether Christopher Columbus Day and the Friday after Thanksgiving shall be holidays. Where it is determined that Columbus Day or the Friday after Thanksgiving is not a holiday, public business may be conducted thereon.

Any agreement between a public employer and an employee organization citing Veterans Day as the fourth Monday in October shall be amended to cite Veterans Day as November 11.
