RESOLUTION #26-04

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO NEGOTIATE
AND EXECUTE A SEPARATION AGREEMENT WITH FIRE CHIEF MIKE
MOHLER AND AN INTERIM FIRE SERVICE AGREEMENT WITH SPRING LAKE
PARK-BLAINE-MOUNDS VIEW FIRE DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, the Lexington City Council has considered matters relating to the employment of Fire Chief Mike Mohler; and

WHEREAS, the Lexington City Council has also considered the City's need for continuity of fire service leadership and operations on an interim basis; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds it to be in the best interests of the City to authorize the City Administrator to negotiate the terms of a separation agreement with Fire Chief Mike Mohler; and, the terms of an interim fire service agreement with Spring Lake Park-Blaine-Mounds View Fire Department ("SBM"); and


WHEREAS, the City Council further finds that time is of the essence and that it is in the best interests of the City to avoid the need for a special meeting of the City Council to approve final terms.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Lexington, Minnesota, as follows:

1. The City Administrator is authorized to negotiate the details of a separation agreement between the City of Lexington and Fire Chief Mike Mohler.
2. The City Administrator is authorized to negotiate the details of an interim fire service agreement between the City of Lexington and Spring Lake Park-Blaine-Mounds View Fire Department.
3. The City Attorney is directed and authorized to assist in drafting and reviewing such agreements.
4. Because time is of the essence, and in order to avoid the need to call a special meeting of the City Council, the City Administrator is further authorized to execute and bind the City to:
 - a. A separation agreement with Mike Mohler; and


- b. An interim fire service agreement with Spring Lake Park-Blaine-Mounds View Fire Department, provided that such agreements are consistent with the direction given by the City Council.
